Day 1 to Day 4 Tour ITINERARY

DAY 1 | MONDAY, NOV 9, 2026 FLY FROM THE USA TO ATHENS

Depart from the US on your overnight flight to Athens, beginning your journey through Greece's rich history and biblical sites. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight as anticipation builds for the adventure ahead.

Overnight: On Board

DAY 2 | TUESDAY, NOV 10, 2026 ARRIVE IN ATHENS – FREE AFTERNOON (D)

Welcome to Athens! The most celebrated city of the ancient world and the center of Greek philosophy. Upon arrival, you will be met by your group escort and transfer to your hotel for check-in. A welcome meeting followed by dinner at the hotel.

DAY 3 | WEDNESDAY, NOV 11, 2026 FULL DAY ATHENS CITY TOUR – MARS' HILL (B/D)

After breakfast, meet your guide and start your tour of Athens. We will start our day at the marble-capped Acropolis Hill to visit the famous Parthenon and Erechtheion Temples. Then walk to nearby Mars' Hill (Areopagus) (Acts 17:22), where Paul delivered his soul-stirring sermon to the giants of philosophy, logic, and learning, speaking about the inscription "to an unknown god." After a break for lunch on your own, visit the Acropolis Museum, built to house artifacts found on the archaeological site of the Acropolis, spanning from the Greek Bronze Age through Roman and Byzantine Greece. Enjoy free time in the afternoon. Return to the hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 4 | THURSDAY, NOV 12, 2026 ANCIENT CORINTH TOUR (B/D)

Drive along the Saronic Gulf and enjoy a quick photo stop at the historic Corinth Canal. Continue to the Corinth archaeological site (Acts 18:1–18), where the Apostle Paul lived and worked, establishing a thriving church and later sending two of his epistles, now part of the New Testament. See the sites associated with his ministry: the Agora, the Temple of Apollo, the Roman Odeon, the Bema, and Gallio's Seat. The small local archaeological museum is an absolute must! Return to Athens in the afternoon for free time. In the evening, attend a meeting followed by dinner at the hotel.

Day 5 to Day 8 Tour ITINERARY



DAY 5 | FRIDAY, NOV 13, 2026 CRUISE TO MYKONOS (B/L/D)

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the port for embarkation on the Greek Islands cruise. Sail at 1:00 p.m. and enjoy lunch onboard. Our first port of call is Mykonos, where you'll have free time to walk and explore the town. Stroll through the whitewashed, flower-decked alleyways, climb to the sculptured church of Paraportiani, or walk along the waterfront of "Little Venice" to the famous windmills. Enjoy dinner onboard, and at 11:00 pm we sail for Kusadasi, Turkey.

DAY 6 | SATURDAY, NOV 14, 2026 KUSADASI (EPHESUS) – PATMOS (B/L/D)

Arrive at Kusadasi port in Turkey at 6:30 a.m. for our included excursion to Ancient Ephesus (Acts 18:19–21), where the Apostle Paul preached, lived, and worked for several years. Tour the spectacular ruins of this city, founded in the 10th century B.C. After the visit, return to the port for re-embarkation at lunchtime and sail to Patmos. Arrive in Patmos (Revelation 1:9) in the afternoon for our included excursion to the Monastery of John the Evangelist, where he was exiled and wrote the Book of Revelation. We will also visit the Grotto of the Revelation (Cave of the Apocalypse) before returning to the ship. Sail to Heraklion, Crete, and enjoy dinner onboard.

DAY 7 | SUNDAY, NOV 15, 2026 CRETE & SANTORINI (B/L/D)

At 7:00 a.m., arrive at Heraklion, Crete (Acts 27:7–13). Enjoy the morning at leisure or join an optional excursion to the Minoan Palace of Knossos, home of King Minos and the legendary Minotaur (half bull, half man). Embarkation at 11:00 a.m. and set sail for Santorini at noon. In the afternoon, attend a church service en route to Santorini, the island with the most magnificent landscape! Ride the cable car up to the whitewashed town of Thera, perched high on the rim of the ancient volcano, or join an optional excursion to the village of Oia, known for its fabulous sunsets and blue-domed churches. Set sail back to the port of Lavrio around 9:30 p.m.

DAY 8 | MONDAY, NOV 16, 2026 DISEMBARK – BATTLEFIELD OF THERMOPYLAE – METEORA MONASTERIES - KALAMBAKA (B/D)

Disembark after breakfast and meet your guide to begin the journey north. On the way to Meteora, we will stop at the historic battlefield to see the statue of King Leonidas and learn about the heroic stand of the 300 Spartans against the Persian army. We will then continue to visit the spectacular UNESCO site of the Meteora Monasteries, built atop huge gray boulders towering over the valley. These Byzantine monasteries house superb icons and manuscripts from the 14th century. We will end our day by driving to Kalambaka, one of Greece's most picturesque towns. Check in at the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9 to Day 11 Tour ITINERARY



DAY 9 | TUESDAY, NOV 17, 2026 **BEREA – *VERGINA – THESSALONIKI (B/D)**

This morning, we will drive north and visit Berea (Acts 17:10–15) to see the mosaic monument commemorating the Apostle Paul's preaching. If time permits, we will continue to the *Vergina archaeological site, famous for the royal tombs of ancient Macedonian kings, including King Philip II (father of Alexander the Great). Continue to Thessaloniki (Acts 17:1–13) for a panoramic city tour, viewing the Old City Walls, White Tower, Galerius Arch, and the Rotunda. Check in at the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner at hotel

DAY 10 | WEDNESDAY, NOV 18, 2026 **PHILIPPI – KAVALA – THESSALONIKI (B/D)**

In the morning, drive to Philippi, where the Apostle Paul established a strong church and sent his letter (Acts 16:9–33). See the river where Lydia was baptized, the ruins of the prison where Paul and Silas were kept, the Agora, the 5th- and 6th-century Basilica, and the Theater. Continue to Kavala, the ancient port of Neapolis (Acts 16:11), for a panoramic tour before returning to Thessalonica for overnight.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner at hotel

DAY 11 | THURSDAY, NOV 19, 2026 **DEPART FROM THESSALONIKI (B)**

As you reflect on the past few days, full of history and spiritual inspiration, transfer to Thessaloniki Airport for your flight home. You will arrive back in the U.S. this evening.

Cancellation policy

Once a deposit or full payment has been made, all cancellations must be submitted **in writing**. Cancellation penalties will be applied based on the **date the written cancellation is received**.

- 160+ days before departure: **Full refund of tour deposit**, minus a \$300 per person cruise cancellation fee
- 159–120 days before departure: **Loss of first deposit (\$500 per person)**
- 119–90 days before departure: **Loss of first and second deposits (\$1,500 per person)**
- 89–60 days before departure: **Loss of 70%** of the total land and cruise tour cost
- 59–30 days before departure: **Loss of 80%** of the total land and cruise tour cost
- 29 days or less before departure: **Loss of 100%** of the total tour cost

Deposits & Payment Deadlines

- \$500 per person first tour deposit due by **April 1, 2026**
- \$1,000 per person second tour deposit due by **June 1, 2026**
- Final payment due by **August 3, 2026**
- A 4% credit card handling fee applies to final payments made by credit or debit card
- Final Payment Methods
- Final payment may be made by check, ACH, or credit card.
- If the final payment is made by credit or debit card, a 4% handling fee will be added to the tour balance.
- The two deposit payments, even if made by credit card, do not incur this fee.
